IMPORTANT: Before you begin, ensure the mounting hardware has been properly installed on your wheelchair by a qualified professional and the M90 wheels are attached.

CALIBRATING YOUR M90

M90 wheels should be calibrated before first use. Calibration is needed during initial setup or when switching to a different chair.

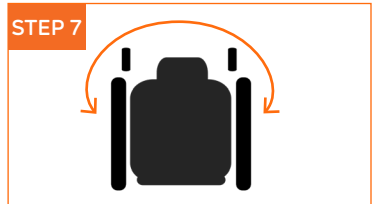
The calibration process sets the M90's slope and hill thresholds based on the wheelchair, optimizing performance for the rider.

NOTE Re-calibrating the wheels is the first step for any troubleshooting with the M90.

CALIBRATION INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT: Do not move the chair during calibration.

1. Engage the wheelchair wheellocks, and remove the battery on the M90 wheel.
2. Press and hold either button on the wheel while re-inserting the battery.
3. When the lights turn **ORANGE** release the button.
4. Wait until the lights turn **WHITE** then **GREEN**.
5. When the lights are **GREEN**, remove and re-insert the battery. The wheel will beep.
6. Repeat steps 1 – 5 on the other wheel.
7. Remove and swap wheels to the opposite sides and repeat steps 1 – 6.



POWERING ON/OFF

When the batteries are installed, the wheels are powered on. The wheels will automatically search for the controller via a BTE connection.

NOTE Buttons on the M90 wheels are used as indicators and trouble shooting, not as an On/Off.

THE DUAL CONTROLLER

Your M90 comes with two driving options:



SPEED CONTROLLER TOGGLE

Speed control only
(handrim steering)



ALL-WAY TOGGLE

Both steering and speed control

CONNECTING THE CONTROLLER

IMPORTANT: The Controller must be attached to the docking tray to use the M90.

Press the Controller Power button once.

The Power Indicator LED (2) will flash white while connecting. (This may take up to 5 seconds.)

When connected, you will hear a beep, and the Power LED (2) will turn solid green.

With the wheels engaged, hold the toggle forward to enter drive mode. Both wheels will lock into place with a click, and the status light (3) will turn green when ready.

FUNCTIONS	ALL-WAY TOGGLE CONTROLLER	SPEED CONTROLLER with HANDRIM STEERING
START / STOP	<p>Push All-Way toggle forward to start. Let go of the toggle to stop. Handrims do not affect speed.</p>	<p>Tap Speed Controller toggle to start. Push speed controller toggle down or use handrims to stop gradually.</p>
SPEED CONTROL	<p>Push All-Way toggle forward or backward to proportionately accelerate or slow down.</p>	<p>Tap Speed Controller toggle to increase or decrease speed step by step, up to level 5 in both profiles.</p>
STEERING	<p>Move All-Way toggle in desired direction to steer.</p>	<p>Steer manually using the handrims.</p>
CRUISE CONTROL	<p>Press the All-Way toggle forward until desired speed is reached, then press down to activate.</p> <p>Steer by moving the All-Way toggle right or left.</p> <p>Exit by moving the All-Way toggle forward or back, or pressing down.</p>	<p>Tap Speed Controller toggle forward or backward to increase or decrease speed level.</p> <p>Steer manually with handrims.</p> <p>Exit by pressing Speed Controller toggle down or by grabbing and holding the handrims.</p>
MANUAL ASSIST	N/A	<p>A gentle boost that engages after a stop and allows you to reposition your chair using the handrims.</p>
DRIVE PROFILE Indoor/Outdoor	<p>Select using the M90 App or the Dual Controller</p>	<p>Select using the M90 App or the Dual Controller</p>
DRIVE SETTING	<p>Choose speed range (Base / Standard / Max) using the M90 App.</p>	<p>Choose speed range (Base / Standard / Max) using the M90 App.</p>

SAFE DRIVING TIPS

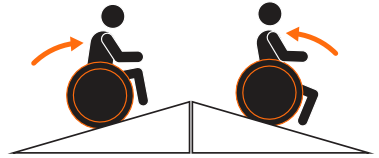
Start Slow. We recommend anti-tips when operating the M90.

Start in Indoor mode in a safe, open environment. Practice stopping at specific points, turning while stationary, and turning while in motion.

HILLS

Begin on a moderate hill with a gradual slope and a safe runout, avoiding immediate turns at the bottom. The M90 provides braking and descent control.

Adjust your body position to maintain balance and prevent tipping – leaning forward to go up or backward to descend. Ensure your trunk is properly supported, if necessary.
